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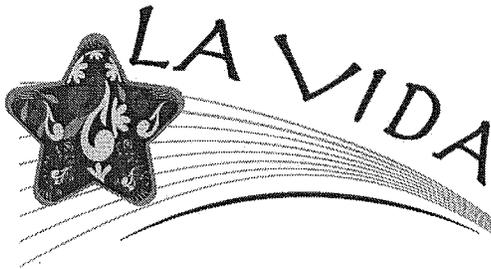
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# La Vida Partnership

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LA VIDA is a domestic violence prevention, support and education program initiated in 2000 in response to an increased demand for services for survivors of domestic violence and a lack of intimate partner violence services in the Southwest Detroit community. The program is a collaborative effort between CHASS Center and several other community agencies.



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The LA VIDA Partnership's goal is to maintain and enhance a culturally and linguistically appropriate domestic violence and sexual assault intervention and prevention program that provides services and resources targeted to Latino/a youth and families in Southwest Detroit and Southeast Michigan. Current services offered include safety planning and short term counseling for women, training and technical assistance for other agencies around cultural competency and domestic violence, support groups for survivors of intimate partner violence and sexual assault, counseling for teen survivors of dating violence and sexual assault, or youth who have witnessed violence, legal assistance and prevention programming targeting Southwest Detroit youth. Immigration assistance for survivors of domestic violence and sexual assault is also provided.
