GIANNA HOUSE	Gianna House is a pregnancy and parenting center that offers support, baby items and classes on personal growth, nutrition and prenatal care to moms in need. Gianna House is soon to be a residence for pregnant teens after renovations to the facility.
GLEN PETERS SCHOOL	Glen Peters School provides special education services to Macomb County students, ages 3 to 26, who have moderate to severe cognitive impairments or severe multiple impairments. The school focuses on students learning, retaining and using skills which are practiced in the classroom and community.
GOODWILL INDUSTRIES	Learn about the variety of employment and training services to people with disabilities or other barriers to employment, specialized programs, including one for mature workers.
GREAT PARENTS/GREAT START WEBSITE MISD	This presentation will highlight the Great parents Macomb website designed for families of children aged birth to five.
