
Common Issues With FOCUS

FOCUS states "User was disabled by system due to security violations"




This indicates that the password associated with the account has been typed incorrectly multiple times. In order to reset the password:

1. Click the "I forgot my password" link directly under the login button.


5. Go back to the FOCUS login page and type in your Login ID, current temporary password and click 'Login'.

Password Do's and Don'ts

Password Do's:

- . Do select a password that contains at least 6 non-blank characters.
- . Do include letters and numbers in your password.
- . Do memorize your password. Choose a password that is easy for you to remember, so that you don't have to write it down.

Password Don'ts:

- . Don't use passwords that are less than 6 characters long.
- . Don't use your name in any form (last, first or middle).
- . Don't use your login ID.
- Don't use a birthdate.
- . Don't use all the same letters.
- Don't write down your password.
- . Don't share your password with others.

If following the steps stated above does not work please feel free to e-mail focus.helpdesk@mccmh.net to reset the password.

Keep in mind that FOCUS requires passwords to be changed every couple of months. This is to ensure that consumer's information is kept secure. It is worthwhile to point out that FOCUS does not let you re-use passwords that have been recently used (in the past 6 - 12 months).

FOCUS states "Inactive"
