This training will focus on identifying eating disorders; anorexia nervosa, bulimia nervosa, and binge-eating disorder in adults and adolescents. Updates to diagnostic criteria as indicated in the DSM -5 will be discussed. Differences between family dynamics, personality characteristics and control factors will be identified as they relate to each of the eating disorders. Medical complications and co-occurring substance use disorders will be identified. Theories on eating disorders will be discussed.
