Busch Secretary-Treasurer	Effective today, individuals who establish service for the first time through any of MCCMH's directly operated clinics must visit their assigned clinic for their first psychiatric visit with a licensed prescriber. This will enable our medical teams to gather the appropriate baseline vitals and laboratory work (i.e. pregnancy tests, urine toxicology, etc.) and allow for a more thorough assessment of all new cases. Applicable exemptions to the above include one or more of the following:
