# Services for Those Experiencing Homelessness

**MCCMH Housing Program** assists people who are engaged with MCCMH and either experiencing homelessness or are at imminent risk of becoming homeless. Call 586-469-5100.

**MCREST** provides shelter for men, women, and families. Call 586-415-5101.

**Youth Interventions - Transitional Living Program** offers supervised congregate living for youth ages 16-20 experiencing homelessness. Counseling, case management, life skills, and education and vocational services are also available. Call 586-477-1855.

**Macomb's Answer to Temporary Shelter (MATTS)** provides shelter to single men, women, and families for up to 90 days annually. Call 586-755-5191.

**Family Youth Interventions (FYI)** supports runaway youth or youth experiencing homelessness from ages 12 to 17. Temporary shelter is available 24 hours a day. Call 586-465-1212.

**Turning Point** has a 24-hour emergency shelter for women and children who are victims of domestic violence or sexual assault, with a maximum of 30 days at the shelter. **Angle's Wing** offers transitional housing for one family with children. At least one member of the family must be working full-time. Call 586-752-3661.

**Amelia Agnes Home** has housing, transportation, employment skills training, and childcare for homeless women (at least 23 years of age) with children (ages 12 and under). Call 586-323-70.
