Where do you start and how do you know the data is valid and free of bias? The following are reliable data sources and factsheets for substance abuse disorder and census/demographics that can help with grant writing and making data-driven decisions.

RELIABLE DATA

Behavior Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS) is composed of annual, state-level telephone surveys from Michigan residents ages 18 and over data focusing on health risk behaviors, health indicators, and chronic diseases both at the state and local level.
