This training will review the Home and Community Based Services (HCBS) Final Rule. The training will go into detail regarding the Final Rule and Case Manager involvement. This training is a new requirement directed from the Department of Michigan Health and Human Services. Per MCCMH MCO Policies 3-015 and 10-007, this training is **required** for all clinical staff functioning as the Primary Case Holder including Case Managers, Support Coordinators and Clinical Supervisors.

The training will review the following topics:

1. HCBS Regulations, Requirements and the role of the Case Managers/Support Coordinators
2. HCBS Compliance Monitoring
