## I. ABSTRACT

This policy establishes the Plan for Behavioral Health Services of Macomb County Community Mental Health (MCCMH), as an official agency of the County of Macomb.

## II. APPLICATION

This policy shall apply to all directly-operated and contract network providers of MCCMH.

## III. POLICY

It is the policy of MCCMH that all directly-operated and contract network providers shall maintain and be guided by the Plan for Behavioral Health Services provided herein (Exhibit A).

## IV. DEFINITIONS

## V. STANDARDS

Behavioral health service standards pertaining to the treatment of persons served throughout their lifespan shall be contained within MCCMH's Plan for Behavioral Health Services (Exhibit A).

## VI. PROCEDURES

- A. All MCCMH network providers delivering behavioral health services on behalf of MCCMH shall ensure that program-level service manuals contain operational guidelines that comply with MCCMH's Plan for Behavioral Health Services (Exhibit A).

- B. The statements in organizational or program-level service manuals pertaining to operational guidelines for compliance with MCCMH's Plan for Behavioral Health Services may be reviewed by MCCMH during contract monitoring activities.
