An additional service for individuals with active substance use disorders





WHAT IS THE ENGAGEMENT CENTER?

An Engagement Center is a short-term crisis intervention facility that provides a supervised, supportive setting for individuals with substance use disorders.

As an alternative to emergency room care or jail for an individual impaired from substance use, an Engagement Center serves individuals who require observation for safety in an appropriate setting.

Individuals are provided with a safe place to stay for a few hours or a day in a clean, welcoming environment.

Individuals can stabilize, have a meal, take a shower, and talk to caring staff. Services are provided by Peer Recovery Coaches.

Individuals receive information and assistance in obtaining treatment services, referrals, and links to other recovery resources, including housing and medical services.

WHO CAN RECEIVE SERVICES?

ELIGIBLE:

- Individuals actively using substances or under the influence
- Not a danger to self or others
- Willing to participate in Engagement Center Services
- Macomb County residents

NOT ELIGIBLE:

- Individuals who require acute medical intervention
- Individuals who are medically unstable
- Evidence of injury within the last 48 hours
- Combative or reasonably believe they would be difficult for staff to control or observe
- Actively psychotic or experiencing thoughts of harm to self or others

GOALS

- Provide a community supervised, supportive setting for intoxicated/impaired individuals
- Help individuals begin their path to recovery
- Assist individuals in connecting with substance use treatment and recovery services

HIGHLIGHTS

- Available on a 24/7 basis
- Staff are trained Peer Recovery Coaches with lived recovery experience

SERVICES PROVIDED

- Triage for safety needs 24-hour monitoring
- Regular vitals and safety checks
- Oral rehydration and food service
- Shower and laundry
- Resources for substance use treatment and supports
- Resources for physical and behavioral health services
- Resources for housing services
- Introduction to Recovery Coaches and recovery community
- Development of a recovery plan
