Crisis Services

If you're experiencing a mental health crisis, call the 24/7 MCCMH Crisis Line at 586-307-9100. Our team will listen, offer support, and connect you with our services and community resources.

For immediate, in-person assistance, our mobile crisis teams are available 24/7 for adults and children. Call the Crisis Line and ask for the mobile crisis therapist. They will assess the situation and determine the best way to help.

If you or someone you know is in a substance use-related crisis, you can call our Crisis Line for a screening and referral to the MCCMH Substance Use Engagement Center.

We also provide same-day or next-day services for those in crisis at our walk-in locations.
