WHAT IS CROSSROADS CLUBHOUSE?

Crossroads Clubhouse is a psychosocial rehabilitation program based on the Work-Ordered Day model. It offers a structured, supportive environment where adults with severe and persistent mental illness can engage in meaningful work, build relationships, and reconnect with the community.

Members play an active role in all aspects of Clubhouse operations, using their skills and talents to contribute to a shared purpose. Through side-by-side work, relationships form naturally, fostering connection, confidence, and a sense of belonging.

Crossroads supports recovery by offering opportunities in employment, education, and socialization. Members also receive assistance with self-advocacy, promoting a healthy lifestyle, and accessing community-based medical, psychological, and substance use services.

Eligibility:

- Adults aged 18 and older with a primary diagnosis of mental illness
- No membership fees—members contribute through participation
