Crossroads Clubhouse is a psychosocial rehabilitation program based on the Work-Ordered Day.

We believe that members' talents and skills are essential to perform all functions of the Clubhouse and that meaningful work is important for all people. The benefit of sideby-side work is that relationships are naturally built between members.

People who have disabilities, even severe ones, have the potential to not only grow and adjust but also to contribute productively to the community.

Crossroads offers opportunities for employment, education, and socialization. Crossroads provides community support services by helping with self-advocacy, promoting healthy lifestyles, and accessing quality medical, psychological, and substance use services in the community.



Membership is open to adults aged 18 and older with a primary diagnosis of mental illness.
