

Crossroads Clubhouse is a psychosocial rehabilitation program based on the Work-Ordered Day.

We believe our members' unique talents and skills are essential to Clubhouse operations. Meaningful work is important for everyone, and our side-by-side work approach naturally fosters relationships among members.

People who have disabilities, even severe ones, have the potential not only to grow, but also to contribute productively to the community.

At Crossroads, we offer opportunities for employment, education, and social interaction. We also provide community support services focused on self-advocacy, healthy habits, and access to mental health, medical, and substance use services



Membership is open to adults age 18 and older who have a primary diagnosis of mental illness.

There are no fees to join. Instead, members contribute by taking part in the daily work that keeps the Clubhouse running and growing as a community.

Everyone is welcome here. No one is denied membership because of national origin, gender, race, physical or mental disability, religion, weight, height, or sexual orientation.
