A welcome additional service for individuals with active substance use disorders



WHAT IS THE ENGAGEMENT CENTER?

An Engagement Center is a short-term crisis intervention facility that provides a supervised, supportive setting for individuals with substance use disorders.

Individuals are provided with a safe place to stay for a few hours or a day in a clean, welcoming environment.

Individuals can stabilize, have a meal, take a shower, and talk to caring staff. Services are provided by Peer Recovery Coaches and other trained staff.

Individuals receive information and assistance in obtaining treatment services, referrals, and links to other recovery resources, including housing and medical services.

WHO CAN RECEIVE SERVICES?

ELIGIBLE:

- Individuals actively using substances or under the influence
- Adults aged 18 years or older
- Not a danger to self or others
- Willing to participate in Engagement Center Services

NOT ELIGIBLE:

- Individuals who require acute medical intervention
- Individuals who are medically unstable
- Evidence of injury within the last 48 hours
- Combative or reasonably believe they would be difficult for staff to control or observe
- Actively psychotic or experiencing thoughts of harm to self or others

GOALS

- Provide a community supervised, supportive setting for intoxicated/impaired individuals
- Help individuals begin their path to recovery
- Assist individuals in connecting with substance use treatment and recovery services

HIGHLIGHTS

- Available on a 24/7 basis
- Staff are trained professionals, including Peer Recovery Coaches with lived recovery experience

SERVICES PROVIDED

- Triage for safety needs
- 24-hour monitoring
- Regular safety checks
- Oral rehydration and food service
- Refreshments
- Shower and laundry
- Resources for substance use treatment and supports
- Resources for physical and behavioral health services
- Resources for housing services
- Introduction to Recovery Coaches and recovery community
- Development of a recovery plan
