AMSR Training provides a structure for the clinical provider which can be used in the development of a collaborative treatment and safety plan. AMSR's formulation model helps health professionals feel confident navigating challenging conversations and offers key strategies for providing compassionate care to people at risk for suicide.

2. Increase willingness, confidence, and clarity in working with individuals at risk for suicide.
