RE: **EXECUTIVE DIRECTIVE 8 / 2003** 

Prohibition of Instant Messaging and Third-Party E-mail

Account Usage\*

Effective immediately, instant messaging (IM) is no longer allowed on the MCCMH network.

IM involves third-party servers and poses security risks to MCCMH.

Effective, October 6, 2003, the use of third-party e-mail accounts (for example, Hotmail, Yahoo, AOL, etc.) shall be prohibited at MCCMH facilities.

Third-party e-mail accounts pose a security risk for MCCMH. They provide a non-secured access point for virus introduction and also give hackers a possible attack vector to the MCCMH network.

The blockage of third-partye-mail accounts <u>at MCCMH</u> shall not effect a MCCMH staff member's ability to send or receive e-mail from an individual who has a third-party e-mail account. Only the MCCMH staff member's <u>use</u> of third-party e-mail accounts shall be blocked.

This Executive Directive, shall be adopted into a comprehensive Acceptable Internet Use policy, which is currently in development.
