MCCMH ROLE-BASED ACCESS TO PROTECTED HEALTH INFORMATION MATRIX

The HIPAA Minimum Necessary standard requires MCCMH to evaluate their practices and enhance safeguards to limit unnecessary or inappropriate access to and disclosure of protected health information.

Based on this evaluation each MCCMH occupational title is classified into Category A (full access) or Category B (limited access) below. Clinic supervisory staff shall monitor the requirements for access and notify the Privacy Officer if a change in category assignment for an individual staff member is necessary.
