I. Abstract

This policy establishes the Plan for Behavioral Health Services of the Macomb County Community Mental Health (MCCMH) Board.

II. Application

This policy shall apply to all directly-operated and contract network providers of the MCCMH Board.

III. Policy

It is the policy of the MCCMH Board that all directly-operated and contract network providers shall maintain and be guided by the Plan for Behavioral Health Services provided herein (Exhibit A).

IV. Definitions

V. Standards

A. Standards for the Plan for Behavioral Services are contained within the sections of this Policy that pertain to the behavioral health provider network (Exhibit A).

VI. Procedures

A. All MCCMH network providers which deliver behavioral health services on behalf of the MCCMH Board shall ensure that written operational guidelines which describe the methodology/procedures for compliance with the Plan for Behavioral Health Services (Exhibit A) are contained in organizational or program-level service manuals.

- B. The statements in organizational or program-level service manuals which pertain to operational guidelines for compliance with the Plan for Behavioral Health Services shall be reviewed by MCCMH during contract monitoring activities.
