

I. Abstract

This policy establishes the applicability of Macomb County Community Mental Health (MCCMH) Recipient Rights policies to its network providers.

II. Application

This policy shall apply to all directly-operated and contract network providers of the MCCMH Board.

III. Policy

It is the policy of the MCCMH Board that:

- A. Each directly-operated and contract network provider of the Board, except licensed hospitals, shall adhere to ALL Chapter 9 Recipient Rights MCO policies which contain standards and procedures for rights protection and ensure the protection of recipients from, and prevent the recurrence of, violations of rights guaranteed by Chapter 7 & 7A of the Code; and
- B. Licensed hospitals under contract with the Board shall establish an Office of Recipient Rights pursuant to the Michigan Mental Health Code section 755 (MCL 330.1755). Licensed hospitals shall also have written policies consistent with Michigan Mental Health Code section 752 (MCL 330.1752). Those policies will be submitted to the MCCMH Office of Recipient Rights (ORR) for review and concurrence to ensure that the rights protection system of each provider is in compliance with the Michigan Mental Health Code and is of a uniformly high standard.

- C. For residential placements in a bordering state, MCCMH and the provider shall comply with all provisions of Michigan Mental Health Code § 330.1919.
